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What does the Board of Adjustment Do?

Members of the Board of Adjustment meet once a month and have the powers and duties that are expressly identified in Brownsville's Unified Development Code (UDC), including hearing and acting on applications for variances, special exceptions, and appeals of administrative decisions. There are typically twelve meetings per year.

Composition of Board?

The Board of Adjustment (BOA) is composed of seven (7) regular members, appointed by the City Commission and shall serve for a two-year term.

Compensation?

This is a non-paid position for public service.
