An Examination will be administered on Thursday, December 2, 2021, for the position of FIREFIGHTER/PARAMEDIC for the CITY OF BROWNSVILLE. Be advised test date is subject to change due to potential local, state, or federal mandates.

Applicants (MALE or FEMALE) must be a minimum of 18 years of age and not be over the age of 36 at the time of testing (no exceptions). Must be able to pass the Physical, Mental and Background Investigation. All applicants must be able to read and write the English Language and must have a High School Diploma or GED. All Applicants must be eligible for future certification by the Commission on Fire Protection Personal Standards and Education. The eligibility list will be valid for one (1) year.

**SPECIAL INFORMATION:**

- Persons who have previously, within 24 months, taken the Entry Level Test, and after interviews and background investigation not accepted for the position of firefighter/paramedic, are not eligible to take this Entry Level Exam.
- Examination will begin at 9:00 A.M. at The Events Center, #1 Events Center Blvd., Brownsville, Texas. Doors Open at 8:00 A.M.

- Applicants must submit a valid Driver's License or Gov't Photographic ID. (Upon entering the testing area, you will be required to present a valid Driver's License.)
- Military Service Credit: Applicants must submit their Military DD-214 at time of registration and must have served a minimum of 180 days of active military service to qualify for the additional points. (Honorable Discharge Only TLGC Chap. 143. Sec. 143.025)
- Existing Certification Credits: Applicants must submit at time of registration proof of their Texas Commission on Fire Protection (TCFP) certification and/or a National Registry or a Texas Department of State Health Services for Paramedic in order to qualify for the additional points and must be in good standing.
- No pens, pencils, papers, mobile phones or electric equipment of any kind will be allowed to be brought into the testing area. (All test taking materials will be provided).
- All applicants who pass the exam and are selected to proceed in the hiring process will be required to take the Brownsville Firefighter Physical Agility Test (PAT). This physical agility test is designed to test the applicant's ability to successfully perform the essential job functions of a firefighter.

- Applicants will be required to bring their own mask/face coverings and must be worn on premises during the entire process.
