



PROGRAM GUIDELINES

Adopt-A-Stop is a program to help reduce and prevent littering. The purpose of the program is to attract public involvement from residential and community organizations, businesses, schools, and individuals to help Brownsville Metro maintain a litter-free environment at bus stops.

RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE ADOPTING ORGANIZATION

By adopting a bus stop, the adoptee is committing to remove trash from their designated adoption area and preserving the stop's aesthetic condition. Adoptees agree to inform Brownsville Metro if the bus stop sign has been knocked down or if it has graffiti on it. Cleaning of the graffiti will be the responsibility of Bmetro's staff. **Participants are asked not to clean the graffiti themselves.** Any vandalism and/or disturbances at the adopted bus stop should be reported to Brownsville Metro. Lastly, participants agree to clean the adopted bus stop a minimum of once a week, or as needed to maintain the bus stop's aesthetic condition.

SAFETY CONSIDERATIONS

By signing the program agreement, all participants are stating that the adoptees will hold Brownsville Metro harmless from any liability or claims for property damages, equipment damages, and personal injury or loss while participating in the Adopt-A-Stop program. Furthermore, the participants should notify Bmetro of any unsafe or suspicious activity.

BENEFITS

After three (3) months of commitment, participants will receive a sign at the bus stop with individuals or organization's name recognizing the volunteer work and post recognition on Brownsville Metro's social media. After one (1) year of commitment, participants will receive a signed adoption certificate and recognition on Brownsville Metro's social media.
